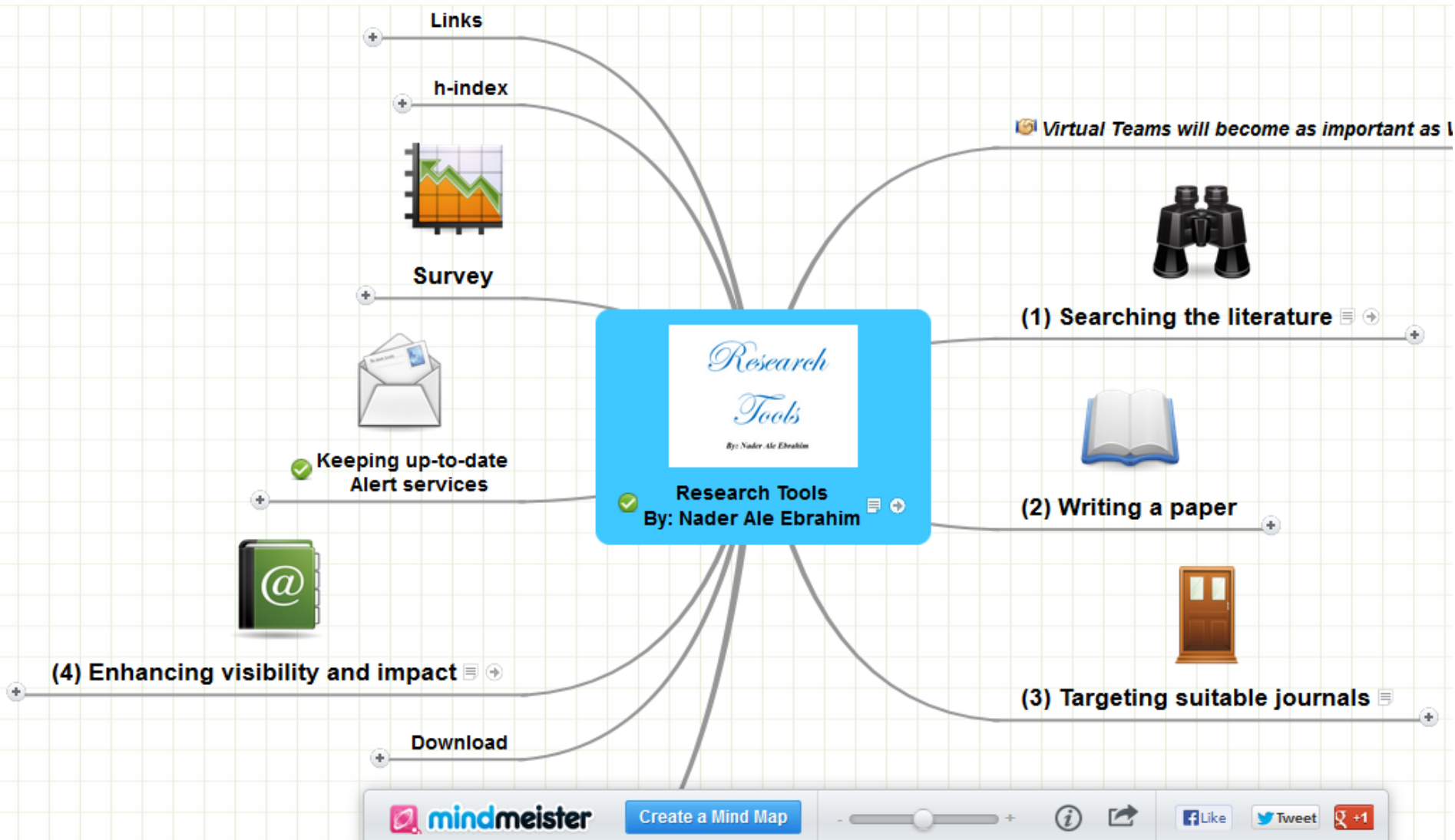

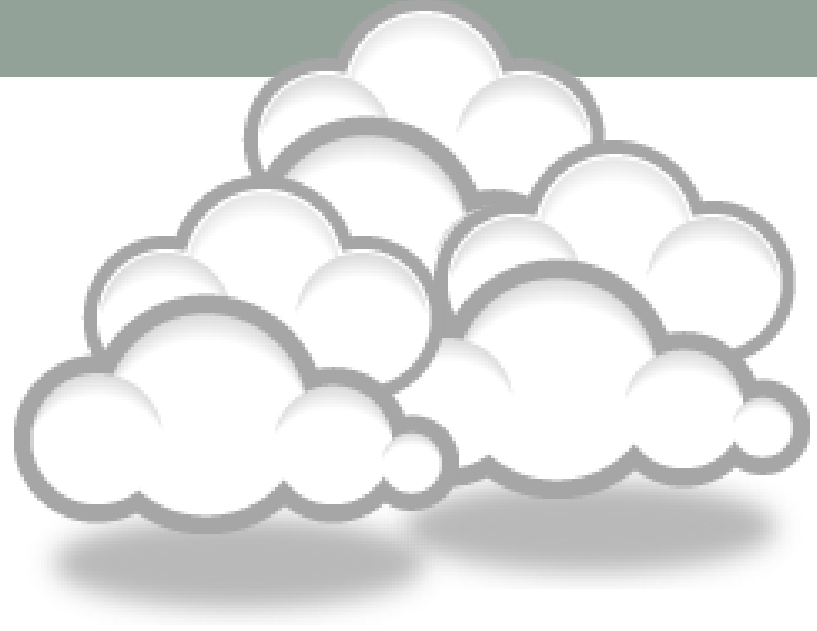

Research Tools Mind Map





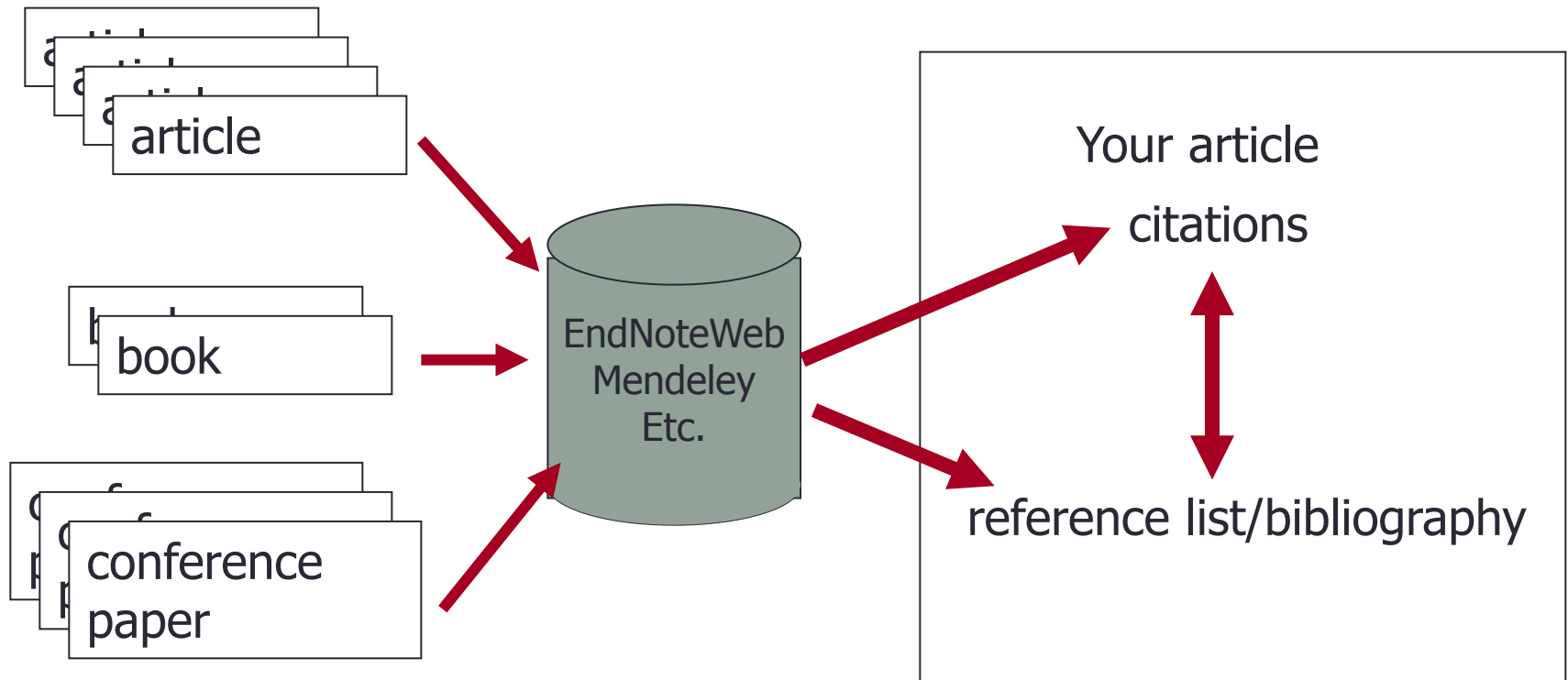

- You can share your EndNote library in Dropbox or other platforms.

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

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

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Conclusion

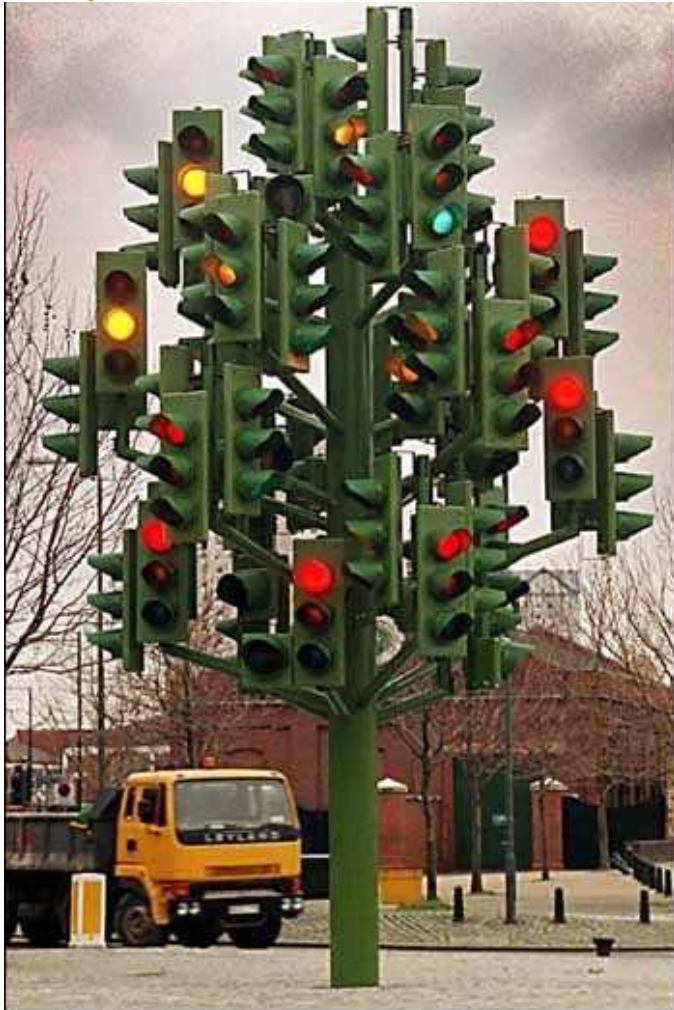
- Reference Management tools save time from a few hours to several days on each project;
